

### PIZZA KNOTS

#### INGREDIENTS:

- 2 tbsp. melted butter
- 1/4 c. extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tbsp. chopped parsley
- 1/2 c. finely grated
  Parmesan
- dough • 2/3 c. shredded mozzarella

1 can refrigerated biscuit

- 1/2 c. mini pepperoni
- Marinara, warmed (for serving)

#### DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400° and grease a 10″ skillet with cooking spray or olive oil.
- 2. Whisk together butter, olive oil, garlic, parsley, and Parmesan.
- 3. Cut each biscuit in half and shape each half into a thin rectangle. Brush each piece with butter mixture, then sprinkle lightly with mozzarella and pepperoni. Roll and pinch the dough together to seal, then tie the dough into knots.
- 4. Place stuffed knots in the skillet. Brush remaining butter mixture onto dough and sprinkle with more mozzarella and pepperoni.
- 5. Bake until the cheese is melted and the biscuits are cooked through, 18 to 20 minutes. Serve warm with marinara.

### CHURRO ALMONDS

#### INGREDIENTS:

- 2 c. almonds
- 1/2 c. sugar
- 1/2 c. brown sugar
- 1 tbsp. cinnamon

#### DIRECTIONS:

 Combine sugars, cinnamon, salt and water in a large skillet over medium heat. When the sugar has dissolved, stir in the almonds. Stir constantly until the almonds are completely coated and the sugar crystallizes, about 8-10 minutes. The mixture should be dry.



melted white chocolate

pinch of salt

1/3 c. water

2. Remove from heat and transfer almonds to parchment paper to cool. Drizzle with melted white chocolate. Let set for 10 minutes. Serve at room temperature.
