# CAT FUN FACTS

## INGREDIENTS:

- 2 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 small onion, finely chopped
- 1 (14.5-oz.) can diced tomatoes with chilies
- 1 (1-oz.) package McCormick taco seasoning
- 2 (8-oz.) tubes refrigerated Crescent rolls
- 1 c. shredded cheddar
- 1 c. shredded Monterey jack

#### STEP 1:

Preheat oven to 350°. Line two baking sheets with parchment paper.

#### STEP 2:

In a large skillet over medium-high heat, heat oil. Add ground beef and onion. Cook, breaking up beef with a wooden spoon, until golden and cooked through and onion is softened, about 8 minutes. Drain excess fat.

### STEP 3:

Add diced tomatoes and taco seasoning. Bring to a simmer, and cook until liquid is evaporated, about 2 minutes. Remove from heat.

#### STEP 4:

Unroll one tube of crescent rolls on a work surface and pinch diagonal seams together. Cut into 8 squares and top each square with about <sup>1</sup>/4 cup taco beef mixture and some cheddar and Monterey jack. Fold two opposite corners of each square over the filling and press to seal.

### STEP 5:

Arrange on prepared baking sheet. Repeat with the remaining crescent rolls, taco mixture, and cheeses.

### STEP 6:

Bake until golden and cooked through, rotating trays halfway through, about 12 minutes. Serve warm or at room temperature.
